**Shelter/Foster agreement:**

The shelter agrees to provide a crate, bedding, food and water bowls, leads, vaccinations and de-worming for the mother and babies, medications and treatment instructions as needed. The shelter further agrees to take back the fostered animals at any time and for any reason. The shelter staff is there to support the foster family at all times. In the event the foster parent needs assistance or just has questions contact the shelter during normal operating hours (Mon-Fri 8-4, Sat 8-3) at 334/567-3377; after hours contact either Ellen Fallon, Animal Care Manager at 334/315-3287 or Rea Cord, Director, at home: 334/252-1002 or cell phone: 334/324-9431.

The foster agrees to keep the foster animals safe and reduce exposure to other animals for health purposes. Foster animals are to be contained at all times and not allowed to roam off the foster's property. When off the foster's property the pet will be under control at all times. The foster is not to adopt any of the foster animals to anyone, but can let any interested person know how to contact the shelter to inquire about our adoption process. The foster will not take the foster animal to any vet without prior approval of the shelter unless it is a dire emergency and none of the shelter personnel can be reached. Please contact the shelter as soon as possible after seeking emergency medical care.
